Subject:-Implementation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana(PMAGY) - Selection of villages for the year 2021-22 -reg

Sir/ Madam,

As you are aware that since 2018-19, this Department is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana(PMAGY) for comprehensive development of the Scheduled Castes majority villages, with revised implementation guidelines with defined monitorable developmental indicators.

2. From the current financial year, this scheme would be implemented as a component of the Scheme of Pradhan Mantri Anusuchit Jaati Abhyuday Yojana(PM-AJAY), which is at present under consideration of the Government and likely to be approved soon.
3. Meanwhile, with view to extend the benefits as envisaged under the scheme guidelines to more SC majority villages, the competent authority has extended the coverage of this scheme to another 6055 eligible villages in 15 States for implementation of scheme for the current FY i.e. 2021-22. The State-wise numbers of these villages are as under:

3. These villages have already been populated on the portal with a different color coding for clear identification of the same. The respective State Govts. are requested to verify the eligibility of these villages as per the scheme guidelines as well as other discrepancies, if any, i.e. name of blocks, Gram Panchayats etc., and communicate the same to this Ministry for doing the needful.

4. Based on the confirmation of the selected villages as received from the concerned State Govts. and sorting out the discrepancies therein, the implementation of the scheme in these villages would be started by the State Govts. only on receipt of the communication in this regard from the Ministry. The eligible funds for these villages will be released in due course after following the procedure of GFR such as UCs etc.
